Phonemic Awareness

Hearing and using sounds in spoken words.

“Shopping for Sounds As you and your child shop, have your child separate the sounds in the name of each item you put in your shopping basket, listening for beginning, middle, and ending sounds; for example, for a bag, your child would say b-a-g. Next, ask your child to blend sounds together to make a word. Say words one sound at a time; for example, you say m-i-l-k and your child says milk; you say c-a-n and your child says can” —Dibbles




Reading Comprehension

Reading for meaning, the ultimate goal of comprehension

“Making Connections As you read a book with your child, stop occasionally to discuss the meaning of the book. Help your child connect what he or she reads with his or her own life. Ask questions such as ‘Where are they? What just happened? Has something like this ever happened to you? How would you feel if someone did that? Do you know anyone like that?’” —Dibbles
